



Nancy J. Dubost

December 24, 1935 - February 1, 2020

Nancy J. (Hoover) Dubost, 84, wife of the late Pastor Louis G. Dubost, Jr., of Pottstown, Pennsylvania, went into the presence of God on Saturday, February 1, 2020. Born on December 24, 1935, in Owings Mills, MD, she was the daughter of the late Almeda (Shank) and Wade Hoover.

She was a 1954 graduate of Western All Female High School, Baltimore, MD, where she was the lead singer for all musical productions.

Alongside her husband, she faithfully served the Lord in full-time Christian ministry for 58 years, where she served as Sunday School teacher, choir director, head of music ministry, and leader of women's Bible studies. She was the Pastor's wife at churches in North Carolina, Michigan, Maryland, Bermuda and Pennsylvania. She most recently served at Grace Bible Church in Phoenixville for the last 13 years. She was a wonderful wife and mother who lived out her favorite Bible verse until the end, Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart..." .

Mrs. Dubost is survived by her children: David C., husband of Amy Dubost, of Collegeville, Jonathan M., husband of Kim Dubost, of Collegeville and N. Joy Dubost, of Washington, DC; seven grandchildren; three great grandchildren; and one sister: Mary Fadely of FL. She was preceded in death by two siblings.
