Nancy E. Rankin, age 82, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Wednesday, March 20, 2024. Born on November 4, 1941 in Colombia, she was a daughter of the late Fidelina Sanjuan and Emilio Cardozo.

Nancy was the first of her family to immigrate to the United States in the early 1960s. Shortly thereafter, she helped bring her sisters to join her. She was a hard worker with an immense work ethic. She had so much fun dreaming of what she would do for everyone, you would think she had actually won the big one! She enjoyed watching Spanish novellas, and often could be found grabbing a quick nap, even in the most inopportune times. She loved her dogs, Lexi who preceded her, and Lily. She loved to travel, having been especially fond of her trips to Jerusalem, Germany, and several other locations throughout Europe. She even spent some time living in France, where her daughter Maria was born.

Nancy was involved with outreach through several local churches. She was involved with prayer teams, care ministry, and coat drives. Her passion was not only for God, but the people around her.
