



## Olga (Chomnuk) High

February 17, 1926 - August 31, 2014

Olga (Chomnuk) High, age 88, wife of the late Samuel A. High, of Pottstown, passed away on Sunday, August 31, 2014 in the Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville. Born in Pottstown, she was a daughter of the late Warfolom and Anna (Motyl) Chomnuk.

Mrs. High was a 1944 graduate of Pottstown High School. She was an active member of Coventry Church of the Brethren, where she was a member of the Senior Choir. Mrs. High worked for the 1st Federal Savings and Loan for 10 years, then retired after 27 years with Sears Roebuck.
