P. Robert Keeley Jr., age 94, of East Vincent, Pennsylvania, passed away on Thursday, July 31, 2025 in the Manatawny Manor, East Coventry. Born on December 25, 1930, in East Vincent, he was the son of the late Emma Lydia (Powell) and Paul Robert Keeley Sr. He was the husband of the late Dolores V.
