June 19, 1939 - February 20, 2015

Patricia A. (Skiptunas) Iorio, age 75, wife of Joseph A. Iorio, of Tampa, FL died after a courageous 15 year battle with cancer at the home of her daughter in Royersford, PA on Friday evening, February 20, 2015. Born in Nanticoke, PA, she was a daughter of the late Ambrose and Mary (Cimbal) Skiptunas. She was a graduate of the G.A.R. Memorial High School in Wilkes Barre, PA. Mrs. Iorio was the chief Voluntary Service Officer at the Wilkes Barre Veterans Administration Hospital for over 15 years, before her retirement in 2003. She was a member of the St. Timothy Roman Catholic Church in Lutz, FL.

In addition to her husband of 55 years, Mrs. Iorio is survived by four daughters: Stacy A., wife of Charles Manganiello, of Tampa, FL; Piper A., wife of Eric Price, of Royersford, PA; Jocelyn A., wife of Michael Ouvry, of Fuquay Varina, NC; Hilary A., wife of James Cochran, of Gilbertsville, PA; one sister: Janet Flora, of Kingston, PA; and ten beloved grandchildren.

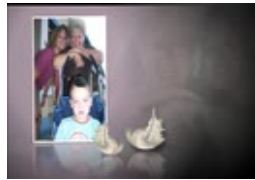
