OBITUARY: Patricia M. (Wilson) Krumenacker, 56, wife of Michael Krumenacker Jr., of North Coventry, passed away on Friday, April 19, 2013, unexpectedly from a brain aneurysm in the Jefferson Hospital for Neuroscience, Philadelphia. Born in Phoenixville, she was a daughter of the late Samuel R. Wilson Sr. and Kathryn P. (Michinock) Wilson, of Phoenixville. Pat was a 1974 graduate of Phoenixville High School. She had been employed for TSC in Pottstown for 15 years and then for Boscov's in Coventry for 5 years. She enjoyed fossil hunting and paleontology and had some of her work published with the American Poet Society. Pat was an active member of the Hamlin Hawgs Motorcycle Club, enjoyed helping with the club's benefits, and loved being with her family. In addition to her mother and husband of 35 years, Pat is survived by her children, Michael Krumenacker III, husband of Jessica, of Norristown, Jennifer Krumenacker, and boyfriend Mike Wunderlich, of Spring City, and Stephen Krumenacker, husband of Ashley, of Limerick; siblings, Cynthia McCurdy, of Bensalem, Sharon Wilson, of Phoenixville and Samuel R. Wilson Jr., of Phoenixville; grandchildren, Adalyne, Alexa, Lillian, and one on the way, and several nieces and nephews.
