Paul A. Brunner, Sr., age 67, of Phoenixville, husband of Barbara E. (Cole) Brunner, passed away on Monday, March 10, 2008, in the Chester County Hospital, West Chester. Born in Phoenixville, he was a son of the late Harry S. and Rose (Varadi) Brunner.

Mr. Brunner attended school in Phoenixville. He was employed as a maintenance supervisor for the Phoenixville Recreation Department for 25 years. He served in the United States Navy as a helicopter mechanic aboard the AGB USS Edisto in the Antarctic during Operation Deep Freeze from 1960-1961.
