Paul T. Schwab, MBA, CFP, age 59, husband of Maria M. (Musumeci) Schwab, Ed.D., of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Monday, September 24, 2018 at home with his family by his side. Born on October 21, 1958 in Philadelphia, PA, he was a son of Margaret (Fisher) Schwab of Phoenixville, PA, and the late Joseph Schwab.

Mr. Schwab was a graduate of North Catholic High School in Philadelphia, and obtained both his Bachelor's and Master's degrees from LaSalle University. He was a member of St. Basil the Great Roman Catholic Church in Kimberton, PA. He worked as a pricing manager for Sunoco. Mr. Schwab loved to travel and entertain. 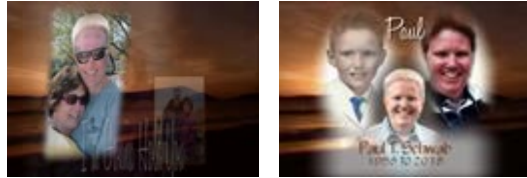
