Pauline A. (Kulikowski) Kelemen, 91, wife of the late Joseph R. Kelemen, of Phoenixville, died Tuesday, April 29, 2014, in the Lansdale Hospital. Born in Fleetwood, she was a daughter of the late Stanley and Josephine (Oponski) Kulikowski.

Mrs. Kelemen was a long time resident of Phoenixville, beginning in 1959 when she and her husband married. She loved playing and singing old time country music, most recently as guitarist and bandleader of Sunshine Pauline and the Seniors.
