



## Philip Krasley

October 22, 1927 - August 6, 2017

Philip Ronald "Bud" Krasley, age 89, husband of Aura Krasley, and the late Lillian (Fazio) Krasley, of Paso Robles, CA, died August 6th, 2017 in the Twin Cities Hospital in Templeton, CA. Born on October 22, 1927, he was a son of the late Mary (Powers) and Oliver Krasley. Mr. Krasley was a graduate of the Royersford High School. A veteran, he served for the US Army during World War II. Mr. Krasley worked in several textile mills in Pennsylvania and retired in 1990 as Superintendent of the Knitting Mill of Prison Authority in San Luis Obispo, CA. He also volunteered his time assisting with the Meal on Wheels program that brought meals to many local homebound seniors.
