Raymond R. Kenyon, 85, husband of Anna B. (Gatlos) Kenyon, of Phoenixville, passed away on Sunday, March 1, 2015, in the Thomas Jefferson University Hospital, Philadelphia. Born in Parker Ford, PA, he was a son of the late Edna (Gaugler) Sperow.

Mr. Kenyon served in the United States Marine Corps during the Korean War. He retired from Philadelphia Electric Co. after 30 years. He also was employed as a chef at several local restaurants, namely Seven Stars Inn and the former Stouffer's in King of Prussia, where he created wedding cakes and worked banquets. He loved cooking and baking, spending time with his family at the shore, and was an avid gardener. He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church.

In addition to his wife of 62 years, Mr. Kenyon is survived by his children, Andrea Kenyon, wife of John Newman, of Lansdowne, Karen Alderman, of Westminster, MD, Suzanne Kenyon, of Westville, NJ and Keith, husband of Cheryl Kenyon, of Phoenixville; and two grandchildren, Stephen Kenyon and Daniel Alderman.
