Reba V. Anspach, of Royersford, PA, passed away at home on Thursday, November 27, 2008 at age 76. Reba was born April 4, 1932 in Sheridan, Lebanon County, PA. She was one of ten children born to the late Charles Hoffman and Susan (Edris) Ziegler. She was raised and educated in Richland, PA. Reba was a 1950 graduate of Richland High School, where she earned the American Legion Award. She also graduated from Lebanon Business College in 1952.
