Richard L. Detwiler, age 66, husband of Linda L. (Overdorf) Detwiler, of Upper Providence Township, PA, passed away Monday, October 29, 2018 in the Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville. Born on January 20, 1952 in Phoenixville, PA, he was a son of the late Lawrence R. Sr. and Dorothy (Chrisman) Detwiler.

Rich was a 1969 graduate of Phoenixville High School, where he also attended the Vo-Tech School. Rich retired as a Union Carpenter in 2004, and was a member of the Carpenters Union Local #167. He was a member of the First UCC of Spring City. He also held memberships at the Liberty Steam Fire Engine Company and the American Legion Post 602, both in Spring City. When not working, and in retirement, he continued to enjoy carpentry.
