Mr. Miller graduated from Altoona High School, class of 1943, as well as Penn State University with a degree in Mechanical Engineering. He also served his country in the United States Army and was awarded the Bronze Star for bravery during combat in WWII. . Dick retired from the aerospace division of GE in King of Prussia after 27 years of service. He was a participant and volunteer at the First Presbyterian Church of Phoenixville. He enjoyed playing golf, and was an avid Philadelphia Phillies and Eagles fan. He liked to read, do yard work, and took great pride in taking care of his cars.
