Richard L. Hookway, Sr., husband of Virginia V. (Bowen) Hookway, of Strasburg, PA, formerly of Limerick, PA died early Friday morning, November 9, 2012 in the Lancaster General Hospital, Lancaster, PA. Born in Pottstown, PA, he was a son of the late Rueben H. and Mary A. (Yost) Hookway. Mr. Hookway attended the Royersford High School. A veteran, Mr. Hookway served for the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He worked for over 37 years for Superior Tube in Collegeville before retiring in 1993.
