Robert E. Cook, age 85, husband of the late Evelyn J. (Welsh) Cook, of Audubon, passed away on Sunday, January 15, 2012 at the Phoenixville Hospital. Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Adam E. and Bessie E. (Snethen) Cook. Mr. Cook served in the United States Army. He graduated from the Murrell Dobbins Vocational Technical School (Philadelphia) in 1950 and also took many college level classes in the late 1950's and 1960's.
