



## Robert Haley

January 10, 1949 - September 3, 2009

Robert (Bobby) D.G. Haley of Mont Clare, PA, died suddenly while vacationing in Vancouver , Canada on Thursday, September 3, 2009. Born in Bryn Mawr , PA on January 10, 1949, he was a son of Elizabeth P. (Thomas) Haley, of Mont Clare, and the late Robert G. Haley. He attended Spring-Ford High School . Mr. Haley served in the U.S. Marine Corps during the Vietnam War. He was a member of the Marine Corps League and the VFW, Phoenixville, PA. He was also a member of Local 420 Steamfitters Union, and the Upper Providence Planning Commission. Mr. Haley is survived by his paternal grandmother; Luella Haley, of Washington D.C., four sisters; Cheryl (Sidney) Carter, Juanita (Ronald) Cody, Denise Haley, Blanche (Wesley) Snider, two brothers; Ronald Haley, and Alex (Lynda) Haley.
