Robert D. Hines, age 53, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Thursday, April 13, 2017 at home. Born on June 19, 1963 in Lansdale, PA, he was a son of Richard Hines Sr. and the late Carol (Lewis) Marshall.

Robb was a proud veteran, serving in the United States Air Force on an Air Training Command Air Force Base. 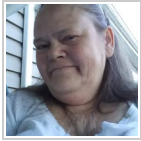

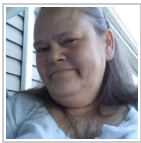

And his name that sat on him was death, and hell followed with him"*

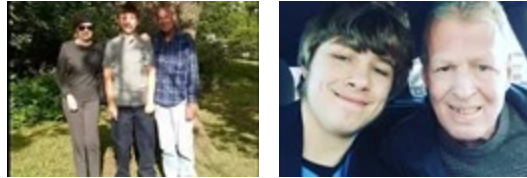
*This was the song at the end of the last movie I ever saw with Dad,
