Robert J. "Lee" Kelly, age 76, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Tuesday, October 12, 2021 in the Phoenixville Hospital. Born on November 19, 1944 in Bryn Mawr, PA, he was a son of the late Robert E. and Agnes S. (Conwell) Kelly.

Lee was a graduate of Bishop Kenrick High School. He attended Villanova University for a year, before enlisting in the United States Navy. He was stationed in Virginia, and served aboard the USS Wright. Lee worked as a mail carrier, and retired from the Exton Post Office. 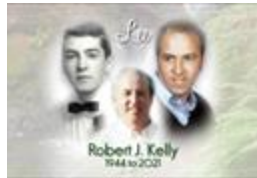
