Robert Edwin McKissic, age 88, husband of the late Laura Jean (Crosland) McKissic for 61 years prior to her passing in 2016, of South Coventry, PA, passed away due to complications of heart disease on Thursday, May 21, 2020 at home surrounded by his loving family. Born on August 20, 1931 in Spring City, PA, he was a son of the late George and Margaret (McCullough) McKissic.

Mr. McKissic was a graduate of Spring City High School, class of 1950, where he created many life-long friendships. Those friendships flourished into yearly class reunions, and monthly breakfasts. Mr. McKissic was the owner of G.T. McKissic Appliance and Royersford Hardware, and was a member of Bethel United Methodist Church in Spring City.
