Robert P. Michener, age 74, husband of Faye L. (Marshall) Michener, of Oaks, PA, died Wednesday afternoon, July 18, 2012. Born in his family home, Mr. Michener was a son of the late B. Franklin and Frances E. (Price) Michener. He was a graduate of Phoenixville High School. Mr. Michener attended night school at Temple University, studying metallurgy. He worked for many years as a tool and die maker serving his apprenticeship at B & F Tool Co. He worked for Moore Products in Spring House for 33 years retiring in 2001. Mr. Michener was a life member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Oaks. He was also a life member of the Oaks Fire Company, joining the company at the age of 18. Mr. Michener was an active fire fighter for many years and also was a former president, fire chief, secretary and engineer.
