



## Robert K. Salamone

July 1, 1959 - October 22, 2014

Robert K. Salamone, 55, of Phoenixville, passed away on Wednesday, October 22, 2014, in the Thomas Jefferson University Hospital, Philadelphia. He was the husband of Diana C. (Branca) Salamone, originally from Norristown. Born in the Valley Forge Military Hospital, he was a son of Kathryn McGill of East Norriton and the late Robert S. Salamone.

Mr. Salamone served in the United States Army and had been stationed in West Berlin, Germany. He was employed as a diesel mechanic for SEPTA and had been a former volunteer firefighter at Phoenixville Fire Department.
