Roman W. Dychdala, P.E., P.L.S. age 54, husband of Kelly A. (McDonough) Dychdala, of Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, passed away on Wednesday, April 25, 2018 in Einstein Medical Center Montgomery. Born on August 21, 1963 in Norristown, Pennsylvania, he was a son of Lydia (Korchynsky) Dychdala of Norristown, PA and the late George R. Dychdala.

Roman was a graduate of Norristown High School, as well a 1986 graduate of Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering. Following a successful career in engineering, he went on to be the Co-founder of Inland Design, an engineering and land surveying firm in West Chester, PA. Roman was an outdoorsman, and liked golfing, fishing, hiking, camping, reading books, and completing puzzles, not to mention cheering for his favorite Philly sports teams. A very family oriented and motivated man, he coached his children's softball, baseball, and CYO teams as they grew up. 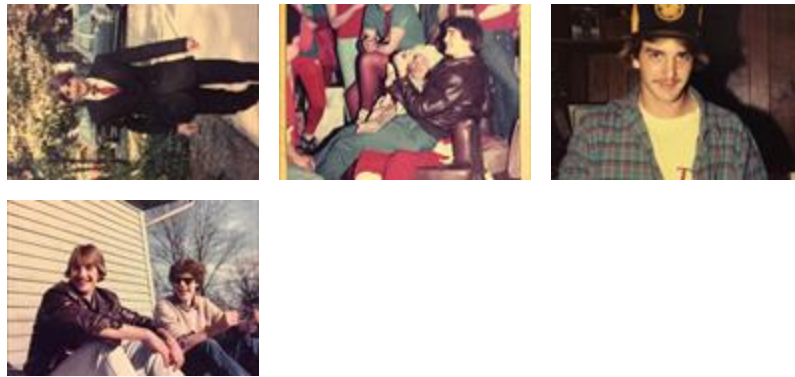
