Ronald F. Sweet, age 78, husband of Deborah Sweet of Phoenixville, PA passed away on Monday, September 30, 2024, at Phoenixville Hospital.

Ronald was born in Jeddo, PA on May 14, 1946. He was the son of Steven and Mary (Kopczynski) Sweet. He is preceded in death by his siblings, Clement, Edward, Steven, Stella, Albert and survived by siblings Patsy, Bernice and Theodore.

He is survived by his wife , Deborah Sweet and 4 children Angela Sweet, Tamara Fogal, William Soos, and Ronald Sweet Jr., 8 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren.
