Rudolph Wilson “Rudy” Harris, age 66, husband of Joan Dale (McKelvey) Harris, of Royersford, PA died suddenly on Sunday December 21, 2014 in Camden, NC.

Born in Camden, NC, he was a son of the late Raymond and Sarah (Toler) Harris. A veteran, Rudy served four years for the U.S. Navy (1968 to 1972). He met his future wife in Bermuda on Memorial Day in 1970. They married on July 3rd, 1971 and this year celebrated their 43rd wedding anniversary. Rudy was a devoted husband and family man. He adored the time he spent with his wife and family. Rudy was the proud father of two sons and their wives: James W. “Jamie”, husband of Kelli (Miller) Harris, of Royersford; Matthew D., husband of Allison (Black) Harris of Philadelphia, PA. 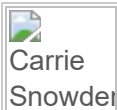
