Ruth Mildred Smith, 85, of South Coventry, passed away on Wednesday, January 19, 2011 at home surrounded by her family. She was the wife of Lawrence E. Smith, to whom she was married to in 1944. She was born in Berwyn to the late William D. and May (Oliphant) McAfee. She attended Downingtown High School. Ruth was a housekeeper for the late Justice Owen J.
