April 30, 1985 - December 1, 2021

Ryan Matthew Boyle died suddenly and unexpectedly at his home on December 1, 2021. His mother was by his side. He was born April 30, 1985 to Anne Louise Boyle (née Kahle) and Gerald Vincent Boyle in East Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania. Ryan was a 2003 graduate of Spring-Ford High School, where he wrestled and worked in the local service industry, bringing a smile to every customer he served. He attended Montgomery County Community College, and was an avid fan of American history, Eminem, and football. His love of the Philadelphia Eagles was only surpassed by his love for his pets, family, and friends.

Ryan's mischievous, heart-warming smile (his friends nicknamed it 'pure joy'), developed early as a young child and somehow, despite adversity, never left him. He had a big heart with which he loved fiercely, making him a favorite amongst his nieces and nephew, as well as every animal he ever met.
