March 21, 1986 - August 27, 2015

Ryan Patrick Gallagher, of Spring City, PA died accidentally on August 27, 2015 from injuries suffered in a motorcycle accident. He was 29.

Born on March 21, 1986 in Bryn Mawr, PA, he was a son of Katherine (Rice) Gallagher, with whom he resided and the late Richard Gallagher who died on September 20, 2010. He was a graduate of Great Valley High School and was currently attending Delaware County Community College.

In addition to his mother, he is survived by a sister, Lindsey Gallagher, of Lancaster. He was also predeceased by a brother Michael in 1990.

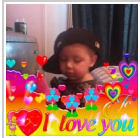

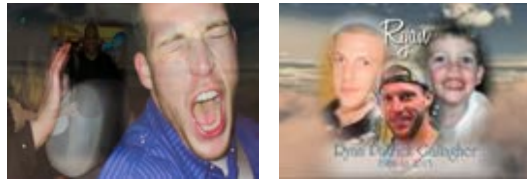
