Samuel Richard "Rick", AKA Pop Pop Mourar, 63, of Spring City, PA, passed away on Sunday, August 17th, 2014 at his home following a courageous battle with lung cancer. He was the husband of Sharon L. (Chinski) Mourar.

He was born in Pottstown, PA to the late Stephen Reeves Mourar and Sophie Lawrence. Rick was a graduate of Owen J. Roberts High School, in Pottstown, PA. He was a long-time employee in the Aerospace industry for General Electric, Lockheed Martin and most recently General Dynamics. 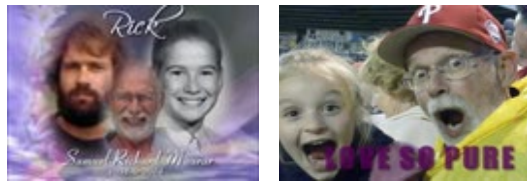
