



## Sarah A. "Sally" Freed

June 5, 1940 - December 22, 2017

Sarah A. "Sally" Freed, age 77, wife of The late Leon C. Freed, of Phoenixville, PA, died Friday, December 22, 2017 in the Presbyterian Hospital, Philadelphia, PA.

Born on June 5, 1940 in Harrisburg, PA, she was a daughter of the late Charles and Kathryn (Miller) Kopp. She was a 1958 graduate of Phoenixville High School, and a 1961 graduate of the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania. Mrs. Freed worked as a registered nurse for the Phoenixville Hospital for over 35 years. She worked in the Emergency Room for 20 years. 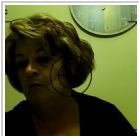
