October 21, 1983 - July 29, 2010

Shaun D. McKenrick, age 26, of Royersford, PA, formerly of Limerick, PA, died Thursday evening, July 29, 2010 in the Neighborhood Hospice in West Chester following injuries he sustained in a motorcycle accident on June 17, 2010 in Charlestown Township. Born in Norristown, he was a 2002 graduate of the Spring-Ford High School. In 2000 Shaun became a Jr. fire fighter with Limerick Fire Company. Shaun and his mother went to the Montgomery County Fire Academy together. Shaun and his mother also worked together at Streamlight Flashlight company in Eagleville, the Waltz Golf Farm in Limerick and more recently at the Orthovita, Inc in Malvern. Shaun was a Transportation Specialist for Orthovita up until his accident. Shaun enjoyed life to it's fullest and made a huge impact to everyone around him. He and his sister Paula would often enjoy their time together going to Phillies games and concerts. Shaun is survived by his mother; Patricia E. Coin, of Royersford, his father; Terry L. (Maureen) McKenrick,, of Gratersford, PA, four half brother and sisters; Paula Coin, of Royersford, Sherry (Bob) Richards, of Pottstown, Christopher McKenrick, of Gratersford, Amber McKenrick, of Gratersford. Shaun also leaves behind many aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, nephews, friends and fellow fire fighters.
