Sheila A. Connolly (b. March 13, 1944), wife of James P. Connolly, of Pottstown, PA, passed away on Sunday, March 4, 2018. Born in Philadelphia, PA, she was a daughter of the late Samuel H. Jr., and Anne (Lafferty) Geiger.

Sheila dedicated her life to extending kindness, love, and encouragement to family and friends. 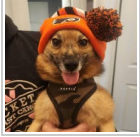
