Susan C. Nachsin, age 77, wife of the late Allan Nachsin, of Spring City, PA., passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, June 16, 2016, surrounded by her loved ones. Born on July 4, 1938 in Pottstown, PA, she was the daughter of the late John C.D. and Jean (Raysor) Corbin.

Mrs. Nachsin was a member of the First U.C.C. in Royersford and a graduate of Spring-Ford High School, class of 1956, which was the first graduating class of the jointure. She then went on to graduate from Penn State University in 1960 with a B.S. degree in education. She taught at Bridgeport High School, coaching both basketball and field hockey, leading the latter to become state champs. She went on to teach special education at M.C.I.U. until retiring in 2008, though she continued to fill in as needed for quite some time after that. Susan was exceptionally crafty and quick witted with a "special" sense of humor and those who knew her will agree, that to say she was hilarious, would be an understatement. She was an extreme Penn State football fan, travelling to and tailgating at many games over the years. She was devoted to her family and was a truly unique human being who will be missed tremendously.

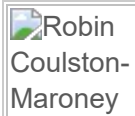
