



## Teena Ann Peters

November 3, 1947 - August 31, 2015

Teena Ann Peters, of Phoenixville, Pa., passed away Monday, August 31, 2015. Teena was born in Battle Creek, Mich., on November 3, 1947 to the late Col. George Marion Peters and Agnes (Klembecki) Peters.

Her father's military assignments allowed her to live all over the world bringing her to Phoenixville in high school where she chose to make her home to raise her own family. She was a graduate of Phoenixville Area High School and Penn State University. She was actively involved in the community and held positions in the Republican Party, Phoenixville Planning Commission, Board of Elections and League of Woman Voters. She served two terms as Chester County Clerk of Courts and was the First Deputy in the Office of the Prothonotary at the time of her death.

She was preceded in death by her sister, Barbara, and is survived by her brother, Gregg M. Peters (Carol A.), twin daughters Chrissy DeMartinis and Karen A. Pescatore, and grandchildren Talia, Soren and Ian DeMartinis.
