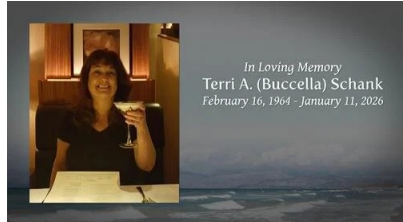

You are truly missed by so many people.

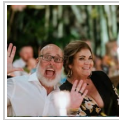
