Theresa R. (Alexander) Schurr, peacefully passed away on Tuesday, September 2, 2025, at the age of 95 years.

Theresa was born on March 1, 1930, in Royersford, Pennsylvania to the late Jennie (Carbo) and Joseph Alexander.

Theresa was the heart of a loving family. She married her high school sweetheart, John "Jack" R. Schurr, in 1950, and together they shared 57 years of marriage and loving memories while raising their family of 6 children.

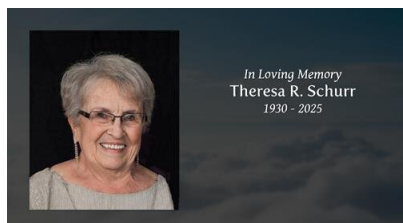
