

Mrs. Theresa "Teri" Woodward

Theresa "Teri" (Hennessey) Woodward, age 47, wife of Raymond E. Woodward, Jr. of Phoenixville, PA, died of natural causes on Wednesday, April 11, 2018 in Phoenixville Hospital. 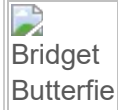
