Thomas George Isanski, age 64, husband of Laurey Rae (Taylor) Isanski of Hudson, New Hampshire, passed away on Tuesday, September 5, 2023 at home as that was what he wanted. Born in Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, he was a son of the late Margaret Jane (Schuck) and Thomas Anthony Isanski.

Thom lived with and suffered from bi-polar disease, and it affected every aspect of his life. He fought everyday to be treated fairly, to not be discriminated against, and to be accepted for who he was.
