



## Thomas Nichols

Thomas Nichols, age 89, husband of Catherine Nichols, of Phoenixville, PA, passed away on Wednesday, May 20, 2026 at home. Born on October 20, 1936 in West Chester, PA, he was a son of the late Alonzo T. and Ruth F. (Baldwin) Nichols.

Mr. Nichols attended Norristown High School, and he was a member of the Pawling Chapel in Phoenixville. He began his career in the electronics industry working for RCA, repairing televisions and installing antennas and intercoms.
