Thomas P. Smith, age 69, husband of Susan (Allen) Smith, of Phoenixville, passed away on Monday, April 27, 2020 in Phoenixville Hospital. Born on September 15, 1950 in Phoenixville, he was a son of the late Ann (Tomcho) and James Smith.

A Class of 1968 graduate of Phoenixville High School, Smitty served in the United States Air Force as a Sergeant during the Vietnam War.
