



## Timothy J. Blevins

March 11, 1963 - January 24, 2023

Timothy J. Blevins, age 59, of South Coventry Township, passed away on Tuesday, January 24, 2023, in the Phoenixville Hospital. Born on March 11, 1963, in Pottstown, he was the son of the late Joyce M. (Bitler) and William M. Blevins.

Tim worked as Farm Manager for 33 years at Ryerss Horse Farm in South Coventry. Farming was not only his job, it was his true passion. Farming began at a young age for Tim, he grew up helping his grandfather at their dairy farm. He was an avid outdoorsman who enjoyed fishing and hunting. He loved being in the mountains, visiting family in Virginia, and time spent with his son in Potter County.

Tim had been a volunteer football coach for Marsh Creek, bounced at the Old Village Inn in Morgantown, and for 27 years served South Coventry Township as an elected official, Township Supervisor

Tim was a great brother, son, and friend, but above all, he was first and foremost a loving father.

Tim is survived by his children: Nathan Blevins, Amanda Blevins, and Ashley Kinney; and sisters: Jackie Cline and Mary Jane Crans.
