



## Ursula R. Lusch

October 13, 1921 - August 31, 2019

Ursula R. Lusch, age 97, wife of the late William J. Lusch, of Doylestown, PA, formerly Kimberton, PA, passed away on Saturday, August 31, 2019 in the Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville, PA. Born on October 13, 1921 in Summit Hill, PA, she was a daughter of the late Earl and Evelyn (Billig) Rex.

Mrs. Lusch was born and raised in Summit Hill, PA. In 1950, she moved to Phoenixville, and in 1952 she and her husband settled in Kimberton, PA, where they would raise their family. She was an active member of St. Peter's Pikeland United Church of Christ in Chester Springs, where she sang in the choir. She loved to sing, and beyond the church choir, she would often sing and play musical instruments at local nursing facilities to entertain the residents. Mrs. Lusch was a lifetime member of the Kimberton Fire Company, where she volunteered her time with the fair and making donuts. For a short time, she had worked at the Kimberton Inn, as well as in the cafeteria and assisting with parties at East Pikeland Elementary School. She and her husband had enjoyed square dancing and were avid campers.
