October 22, 1963 - June 14, 2012

Valeri Faith Frees, age 48, of Alpine, Texas, formerly of Phoenixville, PA died on Thursday morning, June 14, 2012 in her home. Born in Phoenixville, she was the daughter of David M. Frees, Jr. and Mary Jane (Faddis) Frees, of Phoenixville, PA. She was a 1981 graduate of the Phoenixville High School, a 1983 graduate of the Harcum Junior College and a 1985 graduate of the Gwynedd Mercy College. She was currently pursuing a PhD in Hospital Laboratory Administration. She belonged to several professional organizations. She worked in the blood lab for Big Bend Regional Medical Center. As a child, Val enjoyed her contact with people by serving as a newspaper delivery girl for the Daily Republican in Phoenixville. She spent her life serving and helping people both in the hospital setting where she worked, and in the community where she resided.
