August 16, 1938 - April 28, 2012

Virginia R. (Moore) Mallatratt, age 73, wife of Richard "Donald" Mallatratt, of Reading, PA, formerly of Limerick, PA died Saturday afternoon, April 28, 2012 in her home. Born in Philadelphia, PA, she was a daughter of the late Raymond T. and Ruth V. (Bennett) Moore.
