August 6, 1950 - October 17, 2019

Walter T. Dryburgh, age 69, husband of Barbara A. (Pitzer) Dryburgh, of Chandler, Arizona and Royersford, PA, passed away on Thursday, October 17, 2019 in the Seasons Hospice, Phoenixville, PA. Born on August 6, 1950 in Newark, New Jersey, he was a son of the late Walter F. and Anna (DeDominick) Dryburgh.

Mr. Dryburgh graduated from Rutgers University. He worked as a Vice President and Controller, retiring after 30 years of employment with West Pharmaceutical Services. He had a strong Christian faith, and was a member of Royersford Baptist Church, where he had previously served as a Youth Leader and member of the worship team. 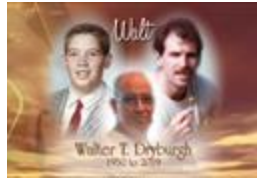

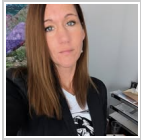
