March 20, 1910 - October 21, 2007

Warren Y. Francis, age 97, husband of the late Laura B. (Biggard) of Cornwall, PA, formerly of Royersford, PA, died Sunday October 21st, 2007 in the Cornwall Manor. Born in Oaks, PA, he was a son of the late Arnold H. and Bertha (Yerger) Francis. Mr. Francis was a graduate of the former Collegeville High School, Ursinus College, and the University of Pennsylvania Law School in Philadelphia. Mr. Francis was an attorney and had his own law practice in Norristown and Royersford. He was a former member of the First United Church of Christ in Royersford.
