William S. Achey, 81, of Audubon, died on Sunday, March 23, 2008 at Phoenixville Hospital. He was the husband of Shirley Ann (McCall) Achey. Born in Pennwynn, Berks County, he was a son of the late Samuel and Mary (Schoenauer) Achey. He was a 1944 graduate of Shillington High School and served in the Navy in World War II from 1944 to 1946.
