William R. Cox, age 81, of Audubon, PA, passed away on Thursday, September 3, 2020. Born on October 1, 1938 in Phoenixville, PA, he was a son of the late William and Margaret (Buzzard) Cox.

Mr. Cox was a graduate of Phoenixville High School, and served honorably for four years in the United States Air Force. He retired following a lengthy career as a communications manager for GlaxoSmithKline.
