William E. Harbison, Sr. 92, of Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, passed away on Monday, May 16, 2022 in Paoli Hospital, Chester County, Pennsylvania. Born on March 30, 1930 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, he was the son of the late Charles and Mary (Betz) Harbison.
