William D. Mauger, age 85, husband of the late Loel (Krone) Mauger, of Pottstown, passed away on Sunday, January 4, 2015 in the Pottstown Memorial Medical Center. Born in Pottstown, he was a son of the late John E. and Blanche (Fulmer) Mauger.

Mr. Mauger was a graduate of the North Coventry High School and a member of the Coventry Church of the Brethren. He served in the United States Army during the Korean War.
